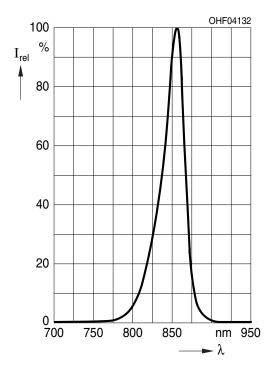

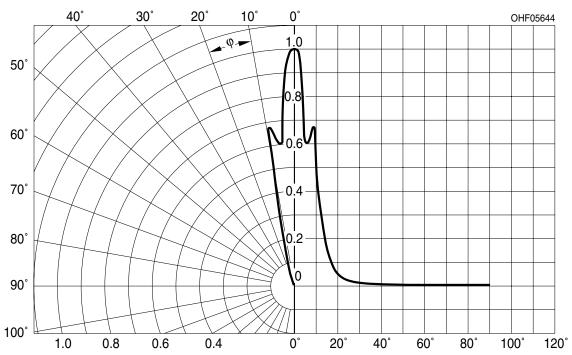

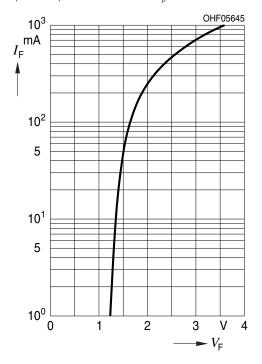
Radiation Characteristics 6), 7)





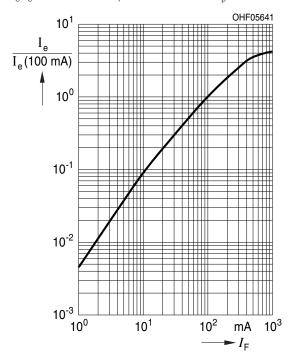
Forward current 6), 7)

 $I_F = f(V_F)$; single pulse; $t_p = 100 \mu s$



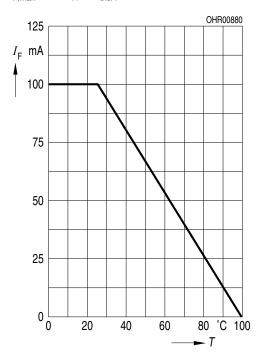
Radiant Intensity 6), 7)

 I_e/I_e (100mA) = f (I_F); single pulse; t_p = 100 μs



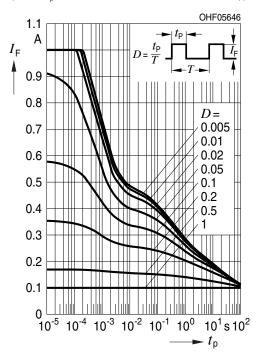
Max. Permissible Forward Current

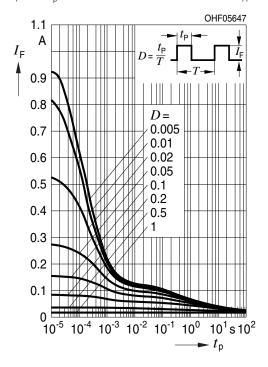
Permissible Pulse Handling Capability

 $I_F = f(t_p)$; duty cycle D = parameter; $T_A = 25$ °C

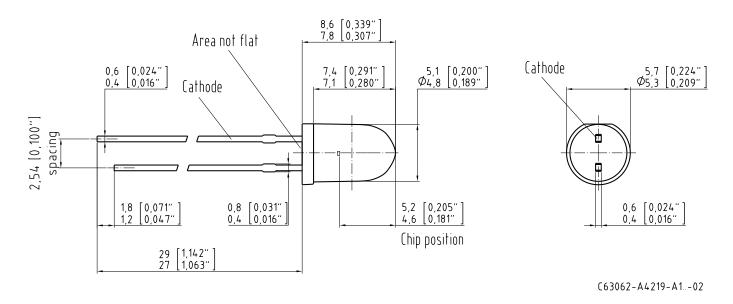


Permissible Pulse Handling Capability

 $I_F = f(t_p)$; duty cycle D = parameter; $T_A = 85$ °C



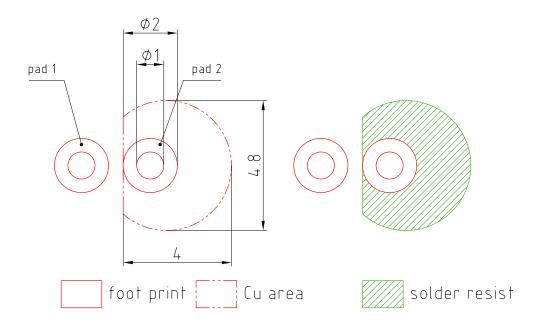

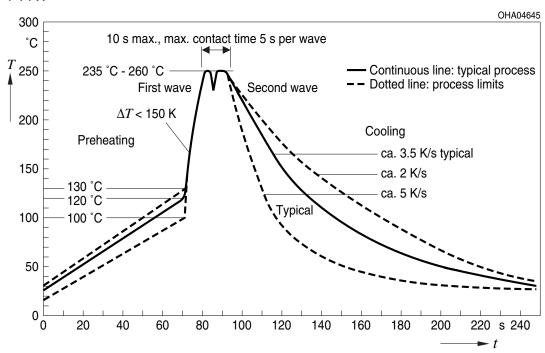


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Pad 1: cathode
